



THE ORGANIZATION OF THE AHI EUROPEAN AWARD - ARCHITECTURAL HERITAGE INTERVENTION – HAVE PUBLISHED THE SHORTLISTED WORKS IN THE CATEGORIES OF BUILT HERITAGE AND EXTERIOR SPACES



A total of 241 projects from 28 different European countries were submitted for this year’s edition. This confirms the growing interest in the event, as evidenced by the high number of new participants, which on this occasion exceeded 50% of the total.

Barcelona May 10_ A total of 26 works (16 in the Built Heritage category and 10 in the Outdoor Spaces category) have been selected by the Jury of the AHI European Award for Architectural Heritage Intervention, a biennial event organized jointly with the Architects’ Association of Catalonia, and whose main objective is to give visibility and recognition to good practice in heritage intervention in Europe.
